I am directed to refer to your letter dated the 23rd September, 1945, enclosing a letter for the Officer Commanding Royal Air Force Station Orford, regarding Flight Lieutenant Harold John Hudson, D.F.M., Royal Air Force.

A letter was received recently in this Department from the Officer in charge of the Royal Air Force Missing Research and Enquiry Service, Holland stating that Mr. Minaard had called at the office enquiring for news of an officer named as above.

It has now been established that this enquiry referred to 143810 Flight Lieutenant H.J. Hudson, D.F.M. who returned safely to the United Kingdom on 7th November, 1943.

Flight Lieutenant Hudson was informed of this enquiry, and he advised this Department on 21st September that he had received a letter from Mr. Minaard, to which he had replied direct.
