Twenty-three of these successfully attacked in good weather except for much ground haze. Some crews reported bombing to be concentrated, whilst others considered that the raid was scattered. One aircraft captained by NZ414991 F/L. S. Clark claimed a JU 88 destroyed in combat over the North Sea. One aircraft (Captain 151118 A/F/L. D. Warren) failed to return.
